Who is Eligible?

- All Alabama-licensed physicians and applicants for licensure
- Physician Assistants
- Medical Students and Residents
- All Licensed Professional Counselors and Associate Licensed Counselors
- Graduate Counseling Students

What can the APHP provide?

- Case management designed to provide support and accountability
- Toxicology testing
- Workplace monitoring
- Advocacy reporting to outside sources such as credentialing committees, other state PHPs and Boards, Malpractice carriers, drug courts, etc.

How can you refer?

- The APHP accepts referrals from any source and all sources of referral are strictly confidential and protected by law.
