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255-X-B Appendix Other Supervision Guidelines

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Other Supervision Guidelines

This document is intended to offer interpretation and guidelines from ABEC to Supervising Counselors (LPC-S) and Associate Licensed Counselors (ALC) who seek clarification of "other" supervision specified in the Proposed Plan of Supervision (PPOS).

Basic Information:

Supervision of an ALC by an LPC-S must include a minimum of 100 hours annually (50 direct, one-to-one, face-to-face personal individual supervision, and 50 "Other" supervision hours).

At least 50 of the 100 hours must be direct one-to-one, face-to-face personal individual supervision with the LPC-S and the ALC physically located in the same room. However, 25 of these 50 direct individual supervision hours may be conducted virtually, provided the LPC-S has completed the appropriate tele-supervision training.

The "other" category of supervision is not intended to duplicate the characteristics or purpose of the one-to-one, face-to-face personal individual supervision.

Expectations for "Other" Supervision:

The LPC-S is to be physically or virtually present with the ALC during an "other supervision" activity.

"Other" supervision can simply be additional direct one-to-one, face-to-face personal individual supervision.

"Other" supervision may include LPC-S and ALC synchronous engagement via electronic means (i.e. telephone or virtual platforms such as Zoom or Teams).

"Other" supervision can be group supervision, led by the LPC-S, involving other ALCs devoted to oversight of their care with clients.

"Other" supervision can be individual or group supervision devoted to administrative tasks that involve client care or procedures specific to the practice setting.

"Other" supervision can be individual or group professional development or learning opportunities where both the ALC and LPC-S are physically or virtually present.

"Other" supervision can be discussions between the LPC-S and the ALC regarding assigned professional readings and materials.
